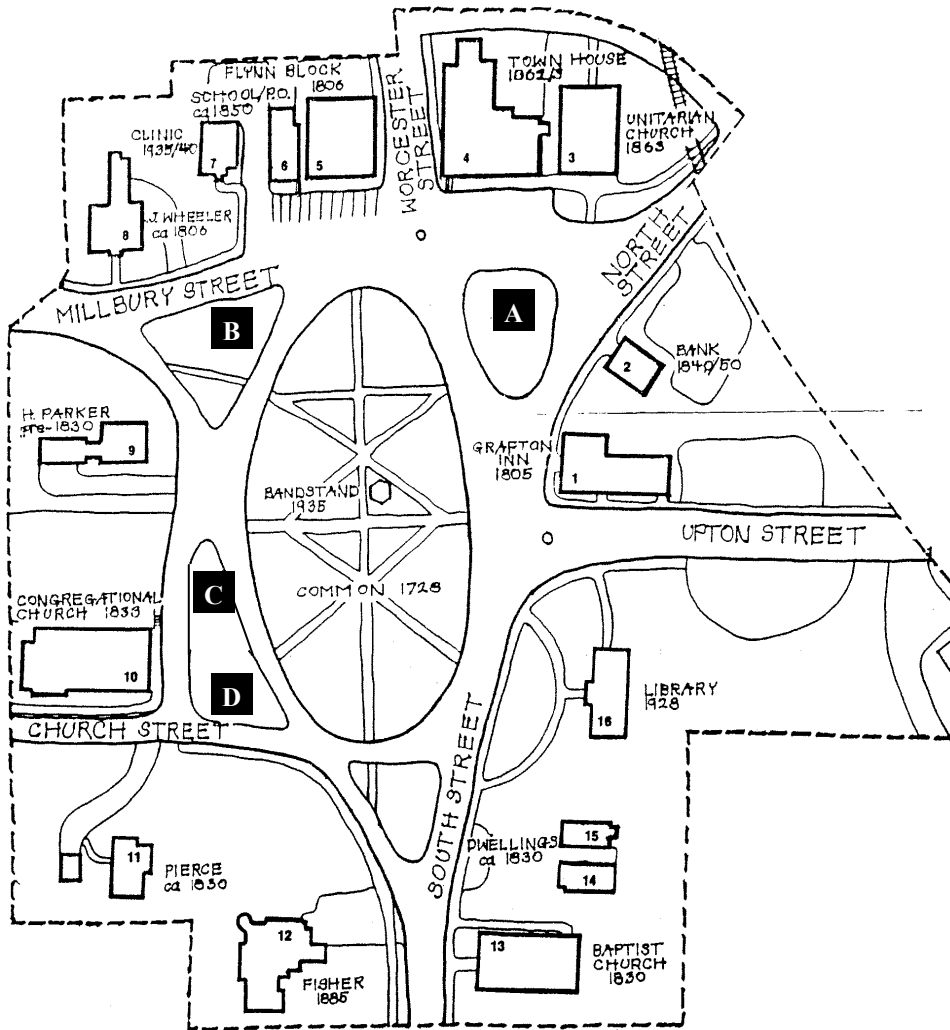


# Grafton Common Historic District
