SHOW PROPOSED REMOVAL RELATIVE TO THE FOLLOWING:

- Distance(s) to Lot Lines
- Distance(s) to nearby utility poles, fences, driveways, obstructions, etc. within 100 feet.
- Distance(s) to any drainage facilities, curbing, etc. within 50 feet.

Before any tree removal permits are issued a Public Hearing must be held in compliance with MGL Chapter 87, Section 3. You will be notified by letter of the place, date and time of the public hearing.

Any work done under a tree removal permit must be performed in strict accordance with Article 33 of the Town of Grafton By-Laws and ANSI Standard A300 (most current addition). All tree removal permits expire three (3) months from the date issued.

If the proposed work is within 100 feet of a wetland resource area, or within 200 feet of a perennial stream, the applicant must contact the Conservation Commission.
