GREETING;

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts you are directed to notify and warn the Inhabitants of the Town of Grafton, qualified to vote in elections and Town affairs, to meet in the John Fitzgerald Kennedy Memorial Auditorium at the Grafton Memorial Senior High School on Monday, the Twenty-third Day of February AD, 2004, at Seven Thirty O'clock PM to act on the following articles, to wit:

ARTICLE 1. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate a sum of money to fund salary increases and to fund the incremental costs of the collective bargaining agreement between the Town and the Grafton Police Alliance, or to take any other action relative thereto.

ARTICLE 2. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate a sum of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000) to be added to Fire Department Account #6220-5942 Fire Truck, for the purpose of funding the final payment of the ladder truck, or to take any other action relative thereto.

ARTICLE 3. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate a sum of money to the Stabilization Fund, or to take any other action relative thereto.

ARTICLE 4. "To see if the Town will amend the Town of Grafton By-Laws, to read: the Chief of Police be a member of the present Grafton Police Dept with at least three years of supervisory experience, or a resident of the Town of Grafton with at least five years supervisory experience in police supervisory or related fields.

Selectmen shall appoint a committee of at least seven, to make recommendations to the Town Administrator for such appointment", as petitioned for by more than ten (10) registered voters of the Town, or to take any other action relative thereto.

ARTICLE 5. To see if the Town will vote to rescind the authorization of the Board of Sewer Commissioners to enter into an Intermunicipal Agreement with the Town of Sutton for the treatment and disposal of domestic sewerage at the Grafton Water Pollution Control Facility as voted under Article 37 of the Annual Town Meeting of May 8, 1995, or to take any other action relative thereto.
