WARRANT

To Any of the Constables of the Town of Grafton, in the County of Worcester  
GREETING:

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are directed to notify and warn the Inhabitants of the Town of Grafton, qualified to vote in Town affairs, to meet in the John Fitzgerald Kennedy Memorial Auditorium at the Grafton Memorial Senior High School on Monday, the Tenth Day of April, A.D., 2006 at Seven O'clock PM and act of the following articles, to wit:

ARTICLE 1. To see if the Town will authorize the Board of Selectmen to acquire by purchase, gift or eminent domain for any municipal purpose a certain parcel of land located behind the Grafton Public Library at #4 and #6 Upton Street containing approximately 12 acres of land more or less and sometimes known as the Perreault property upon such terms and conditions as the Board of Selectmen deem to be in the best interest of the Town and further to raise and appropriate or transfer from available funds or borrow a sum of money to pay for the purchase or taking of the subject land, or to take any other action relative thereto.

ARTICLE 2. "To see if the Town will vote to appropriate from the general Stabilization Fund or raise and transfer from any available funds \$1,037,000 to extend the water line from Magnolia Lane to and through Stoneybrook Road, approximately 9,529 linear feet, as petitioned for by more than two hundred (200) registered voters of the Town," and take any necessary action relative thereto.
