

SINGLE STREAM RECYCLING

IN GRAFTON!!

Recycling can be put out in one or more recycling container. You no longer have to spend time sorting your recyclable materials into separate bins. Now all recyclable items can be placed in the same container for easy curbside collection.

* **No Sorting Is Needed**

- * All recyclable materials will be collected EVERY OTHER WEEK, the same day as your regular trash pick up.
- * Recycling bins and decals are available for sale at the Town Administrator's Office in the Municipal Center, M-F, 8:30 a.m.—4:30 p.m.

18 gallon bins: \$7.00.....22 gallon bins: \$9.00

- * Residents may also use regular trash barrels as recycling containers provided that they are affixed with a "RECYCLE" sticker. There is no fee for recycling stickers. Maximum barrel capacity—34 gallons; maximum weight when full—30 pounds.

What to **INCLUDE** in Recycling Containers:

- Newspapers, Magazines, Catalogs
- Cardboard—pieces no larger than 2'x 3'x 1'
- Paperboard (cereal / shoe boxes)
- Telephone / Soft Cover Books
- Junk Mail / Envelopes (all types)
- Paper (all colors, staples/paperclips are okay)
- Milk / Juice Cartons
- Plastic bottles marked #1-7
- Soda / Juice / Water Bottles (glass or plastic)
- Food containers (cottage cheese/ margarine)
- Glass Bottles / Jars (any color)
- Aluminum (pie plates / trays / foil)
- Metal Cans (tin / steel / aluminum)
- Milk Jugs, Bleach/Detergent, shampoo bottles



What **NOT** to include in recycling container:

- No Plastic Bags
- No Unmarked Plastics (laundry baskets / chairs/ toys)
- No Windows/Light Bulbs
- No Dishes, No Pyrex, No Ceramics
- No Foam Packaging, No Styrofoam
- No Aerosol Cans (paint/hairspray/cleaners)
