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A meeting of the Board of Health was held on December 28, 2015 in the Health Department, Municipal Center, 30 Providence Road, Grafton, MA.

MEMBERS PRESENT: Karen Gwozdowski Gauvin, Chairman; Deborah A. Chouinard, Vice Chairman; and Philip E. Dumas, Member
Richard J. Kirejczyk, Clerk; and Jay Gardiner, Member were not in attendance.
Also in attendance: Diane Guerrero of 126 Millbury Street and Nancy Connors, Recording Secretary

126 Millbury Street

Ms. Guerrero was before the Board because she is selling her house and the Title 5 inspection report came back as "Needs Further Evaluation by the Local Approving Authority" because the Well Water Testing for Total Coliform came back as Present. The Board of Health Supplemental Regulations to Title 5 state that upon transfer of a property you must tie into the municipal sewer system. Ms. Guerrero spoke to Paul Courmoyer at the Sewer Department who informed her it would require installation of a pump system which entails a significant cost to her and would also involve contractors and electrician totaling approximately \$8,000 to \$10,000.

Ms. Guerrero stated her financial hardship to the Board that will prevent her from connecting to the Municipal Sewer System.

In reviewing the Title 5 Inspection Report the Board noted the two cesspools were in working order with no signs of ever being high.

A motion was made by Mrs. Chouinard to have the homeowner hire a DEP certified laboratory to take another sample from the kitchen faucet and submit the results (along with the chain of custody) to the Health Department, seconded by Mr. Dumas; unanimously passed.

A motion was made by Mrs. Chouinard to accept one of the cesspools being 80 feet away from the wetlands, seconded by Mr. Dumas; unanimously passed.

A motion was made by Mrs. Chouinard to grant the requested Local Upgrade Approval (1) Reduction in Setback – to allow the leach field to be 13.3 feet from the foundation. The ground slopes downhill away from the home, and (2) Reduction in Separation between the SAS and high groundwater – 5 feet required, 4 feet provided; seconded by Mr. Dumas, unanimously passed.
