Minutes: David L. Therrien moved to approve the minutes of April 4, 2016 as written. Susan H. Duval seconded and it was voted unanimously.

Treatment Plant Update: Paul F. Cournoyer stated:

- Project Ongoing
- They are done hauling material offsite
- The dewatering is going well – right where it needs to be
- They are digging the final clarifiers
- Building Inspection will be this Friday



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Abatement: David L. Therrien moved to grant abatement for \$86.31 (interest) for 17 Seaver Farm Road, requested by Scott Dunlap, due to interest being accrued On bill that was under advisement for past abatement. Susan H. Duval seconded, And it was voted unanimously.

Refund: David L. Therrien moved to grant a refund for \$149.50 for property at 6 Krula Way, requested by Caryn Francese due to bank duplicating payment. Susan H. Duval seconded, and it was voted unanimously.

Pump Station Alarms: Camp, Dresser, McKee/Smith will put together a proposal For alarm and control panels for twelve pump stations not including Arcadia Street And Worcester Street. Susan H. Duval seconded, and it was voted unanimously.

Sludge Hauling Bid Discussion: David L. Therrien moved to reject the Sludge Hauling Bid from Noonan Transportation. Susan H. Duval seconded, and it was Voted unanimously.

Vacuum Truck Purchase: David L. Therrien moved to purchase the Mach Vacuum Truck as discussed at the last meeting, price not to exceed \$210,000.00. Susan H. Duval seconded, and it was voted unanimously.

Sewer Use Rate Increase Discussion: David L. Therrien moved to raise the sewer Use fee from \$6.50 per one thousand gallons to \$7.75 per one thousand gallons, Effective July 1, 2016. Susan H. Duval seconded, and it was voted unanimously.
