### GRAFTON COUNCIL ON AGING March 10, 2016 GRAFTON SENIOR CENTER CRAFT ROOM

A meeting of the GRAFTON COUNCIL ON AGING was held on March 10, 2016 at 2:00 pm in the GRAFTON CENTER CRAFT ROOM.

Rev. Goff asked if any progress had been made on the Affordable Housing plan presented by John Carlson, Chairman for the Affordable Housing Board, at the last meeting. It was reported that no progress has been reported so far.



New Business: Barbara Connelly reported that gains have been made on the proposed Food Program. New equipment will need to be purchased. The program is slated to begin at the beginning of the next fiscal year. Community businesses have volunteered to donate produce and canned goods. A discussion ensued as to staffing, revenue, etc.
