A meeting of the Grafton Public Works Advisory Committee was held on October 14, 2015 at 6:00PM in Conference Room B at the Grafton Municipal Center located at 30 Providence Road. Members present are listed below:

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Pogorzelski at 6:15PM in Conference Room B at the Municipal Center. The following represents the results of the meeting:

New Business:

- **Accept Meeting Minutes** - John Bechard moved that the August 12, 2015 meeting minutes be accepted as presented. Mark Durfee seconded. The motion carried unanimously.
- **Vote to Support Road Funding** - After a review and discussion of the proposed 2016 list of roads, John Bechard moved that the Committee support 2016 road funding totaling \$1.5 million based on the proposed 2016 list of roads. Mark Durfee seconded. The motion carried unanimously.
- **Wheeler Road** – The Committee requested that Brian investigate the water issues on Wheeler Road and report back to the Committee.
- **Crack Sealing** – The Committee requested that highway operations personnel be instructed to report pavement issues.

Old Business:

- **Glenn Street** – Brain informed the Committee that Glenn Street was scheduled to be rehabilitated at the end of October and that the selected rehabilitation method would be concrete (cement additive).
- **DPW Facility Proposal** – John told the Committee that the DPW facility proposal would not be moving forward at the fall Town Meeting. John indicated that the proposal was to be deferred to the spring 2016 Town Meeting.
- **Citizens Letter Response** – The Committee decided that any correspondence received be handled by the Committee as a whole.

Adjournment: There being no further business, John Bechard moved that the meeting be adjourned at 7:04PM. Mark Durfee seconded. All were in favor.
