Traffic Impact Assessment:

The current traffic flow which is generated by the facility is approximately 166 trips.

That number is based on the current enrollment at the Autism Center, 31 students, which produces 62 motor vehicle trips.

The maximum number of Educational full time faculty staff at the facility is 19, which produces 38 motor vehicle trips.

The maximum number of the Administrative Executive Staff is 7 people, which produces 28 trips.

The second tenant, the Doctors Office, New England Psychological Assessment Center, Inc. has 3 employees and a maximum of 5 clients a day. That would produce 16 motor vehicle trips a day.

Facilities and Maintenance, 3 employees produces 12 motor vehicle trips.


Possible supply deliveries, using trucks, cars and vans, produces 10 motor vehicle trips.

Total trips equals $62 + 38 + 28 + 16 + 12 + 10 = 166$ motor vehicle trips per day.

Centennial Drive is an 80' wide roadway. It is designed to have four traffic lanes, 2 lanes traveling in each direction.

It should be further noted that not one single accident has occurred at the entrance/exit of the 13 Centennial Drive property since the facility opened in the year 2003.

In closing, I feel the traffic generated by the facility would be negligible in size and not a hazard to the general public.
