Comments: We couldn't agree more with our neighbor Lydia's comments concerning this proposal. The intersection of Harris St. and Worcester Street is already extremely tricky, with traffic coming from five different points: 122 north and south, Harris street, Snow Road, and the CVS parking lot. From the sound of it you would have to add a sixth, if the overflow parking at Mike's garage at the same point is added in. I would suggest anyone who doubts this try to exit Harris at any busy traffic time and you will see. There is no doubt that most visitors will soon be rerouting up and down Bernard Road, and drastically changing the traffic, which currently serves perhaps a dozen homes, and is on the way to no where else. We also share Lydia's concern for the impact on the nesting swans and other wildlife. This area, with it's proximity to Ecblaw Landing and the conservancy land right across the water, seems ill suited to this type of project, paving for 34 cars, etc. We have been traveling alot, and only recently learned of this, and hope further consideration to traffic and conservation impact will be taken.
