Meeting called to order 7:00 PM

The Chief noted that he had made attempts to contact all citizen petitioners to remind them of the meeting. Petitioners present included Roger Currier, Jonathan Nickerson, Bill Fairbanks, Malcom Reid, and Joshua Bedarian. Others present included Helen Fairbanks.

**New Business:**

- 1. Request from J.T. Ross to make the intersection of Appaloosa Dr. and Bridle Ridge Lane a four-way stop.**  
After a brief discussion that included sightlines a motion was made to take no action. (MMSP 6-0)
- 2. Request from Nelson Park Library Trustees to prohibit parking on both sides of Prentice St. between Shrewsbury St. and Creeper Hill Rd.**  
After discussion that included new construction in the area a motion was made to place No Parking signs on both sides of Prentice Street between Shrewsbury Street and Creeper Hill Road. (MMSP 6-0)
- 3. Request from Jonathan Nickerson to reduce speed limit from 30mph to 20mph in the Airport Rd neighborhood.**  
After discussion including comments regarding Commonwealth of Massachusetts speed limit standards a motion was made to place cautionary safety green SLOW Children at Play and Thickly Settled/20MPH signs in the Airport Road neighborhood (including Hingham Road) at the discretion of the DPW. (MMSP 6-0)
- 4. Request from Bill Fairbanks to post a “Hidden Street” (or similar) sign on Worcester St. and Donahue Lane.**  
After discussion that included poor sightlines, increased speeding traffic and the removal of the caution light a motion was made to request the Commonwealth of Massachusetts to post a Hidden Drive (or similar) sign on Route 122 northbound approaching Donahue Drive. (MMSP 6-0).

5. **Request from Malcom Reid to post speed limit signs or other devices on Hawthorn St.**  
After discussion a motion was made to place safety green SLOW Children at Play signs on Hawthorn Street at the discretion of the DPW. (MMSP 6-0)
6. **Request from Josh Bedarian for “Traffic from the Left Has a Stop Sign” (or similar) at Upton St. (Route 140) and South St.**  
After discussion that included significant changes to the intersection including new construction, additional parking, and projected construction a motion was made to commission a traffic study and follow-up of the intersection of South Street and Route 140. (MMSP 6-0)
7. **Request from Keri Drake for a crosswalk and electronic warning signs and radar speed sign at the intersection of Old Westboro Rd., Gershom Dr. and Whitney St. and add connecting sidewalks from Grafton to Westboro that connects neighborhoods.**  
A motion was made to pass over. (MMSP 6-0)
8. **Request from John Karoway to restrict GURR truck traffic on Waterville St.**  
A motion was made to pass over. (MMSP 6-0)
