As you know the Board of Assessors has concerns with the permitting of a wireless Communications Tower for [58 Follette Street](#). Unfortunately, I was not included in the request for comments on this matter. Please share the following comments from the Board of Assessors with the Conservation Commission at their meeting tonight:

The Board of Assessors would like the Planning Board to know this property is currently designated as Chapter 61 Forestry land. Per M.G.L. Chapter 61 § 8 "The notice of intent to sell or convert shall be sent by the landowner, by certified mail or hand-delivered, to the mayor and city council of a city, or board of selectmen of a town, and in the case of either a city or a town, to its board of assessors, to its planning board and conservation commission, if any, and to the state forester."

A notice of intent to convert the use of this property has NOT been received and the Town has NOT exercised their first refusal option under the M.G.L. Chapter 61 § 8.
