The **Tufts Cummings School of Veterinary Medicine's** Community Action Team and the **Grafton Board of Health** are holding a **free** vaccine clinic for cats, dogs, and ferrets **by appointment only**. Rabies and distemper vaccines will be available. A representative from the Town Clerk's office will be available 9-11 a.m. for dog license registration (rabies certificate required, spay/neuter certificate required if suitable).

If your pet was previously vaccinated for rabies, please bring a copy of the Rabies Certificate. Previously vaccinated pets, with proof, may be eligible to receive a 3-year rabies vaccine.

Rabies is an infectious and contagious zoonotic disease found in wildlife that can be transmitted to humans. If untreated, rabies is considered fatal. To protect the public, unvaccinated dogs and cats exposed to rabies must either be isolated at an animal hospital for three months or euthanized. Vaccinating household pets is the law in Massachusetts and the best way to prevent rabies and protect your animals and family. Please do not approach any wild animals.
