## IMPORTANT TOWN MEETING INFORMATION

Dear Grafton Voter:

Please be advised that we want everyone to remain healthy and safe while at the same time keeping the democratic process working. We have 41 articles for the Annual Town Meeting and 9 Articles for the Special Town Meeting to consider. ***We urge everyone to watch local cable (channel 192 Charter and 33 Verizon ) or our Youtube channel [www.tinyurl.com/townofgraftonma](http://www.tinyurl.com/townofgraftonma) for a Town Meeting review with the Town Administrator.*** Please note the following information:

**WHEN:** June 20, 2020 at 9:00 a.m. (Registration at 7:30 a.m.)  
Rain Date: June 21, 2020 at 9:00 a.m.

**WHAT:** TOWN MEETING

**WHERE:** High School Football Field and Gymnasium

**Personnel will be on hand to provide assistance and direction as needed.**

### LOGISTICS:

- Registration will be in Basketball Court (to the left of the High School entrance)
- Electronic Check-In will be used for faster check-in but please be patient and expect delays.
- Each registered voter will receive a wristband at registration to facilitate an easier count when voting. No wristband, no vote.
- We will broadcast the meeting from the field into the gymnasium.
- Residents preferring to stay in their car and vote on only specific articles must be pre registered and in the Gymnasium at the time of voting for those articles. If the Gymnasium is at "full capacity" you will need to report to the Football Field to vote.
- Facemasks are required and must be worn at all times. If you do not have one, one will be provided.
- A Deputy Moderator will be in the gymnasium and all questions will be broadcast back to the field and addressed by the Town Moderator.

## REMINDERS:

- Seating in the Gymnasium is reserved for those with mobility issues and those who cannot be in the sun.
- Seating will be provided in Gymnasium and Field maintaining social distancing guidelines.
- Please bring water, sunscreen, and a hat. Please follow a carry in – carry out trash policy.
- Children are allowed at Town Meeting but we are asking they remain with parents on the football field. Children are discouraged from being in the Gymnasium.
- Parking is available at the High School Campus, Municipal Center, and South End of the Police Station.

## LOCAL ELECTION INFORMATION:

- The deadline to apply for an Absentee/Early Voting ballot is Monday, June 22<sup>nd</sup> at noon (12 pm). After this time, a voter must vote at the polls.
- Voters CAN vote on election day in person at the polls from 8 a.m. - 8 p.m. Precincts 1, 2, 3 are at the Grafton Middle School (22 Providence Road) and Precincts 4 & 5 are at Millbury Street Elementary School (105 Millbury Street)
